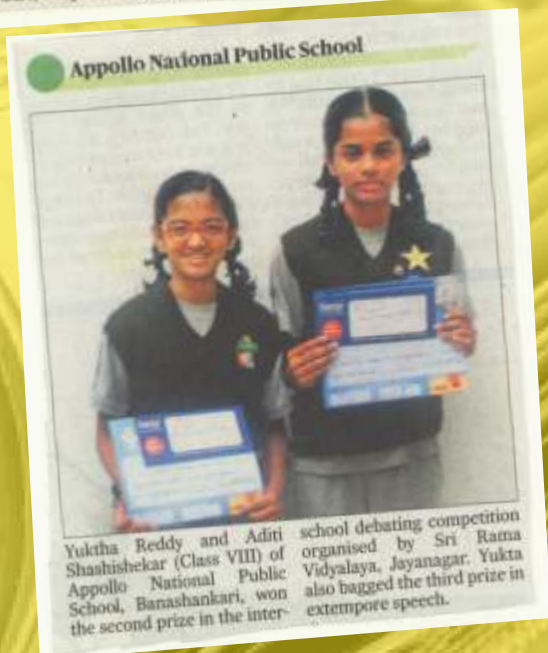
NEWS MAKERS

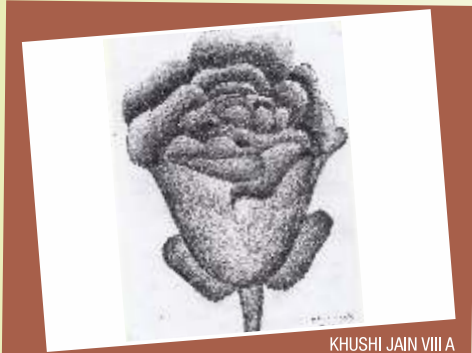

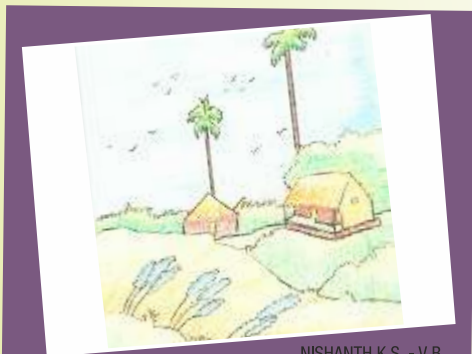
