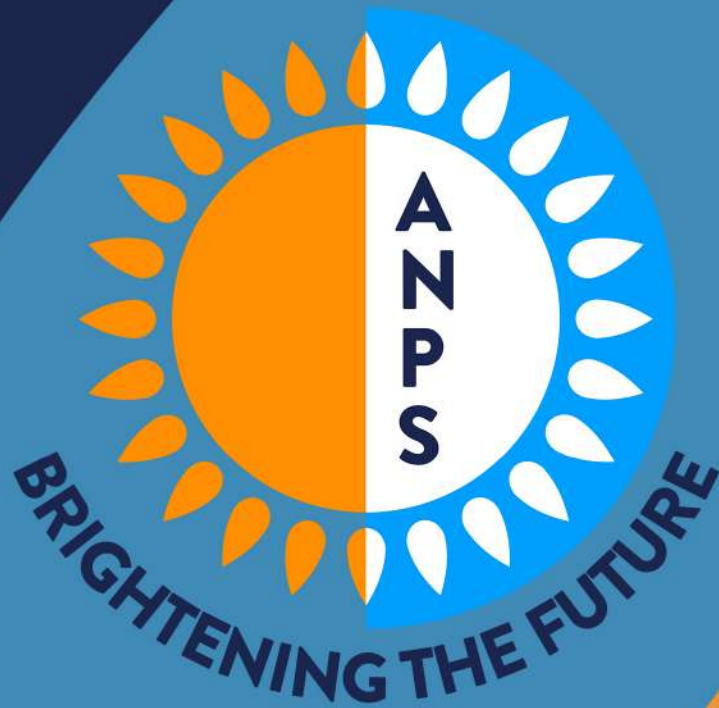

# Throwball Match

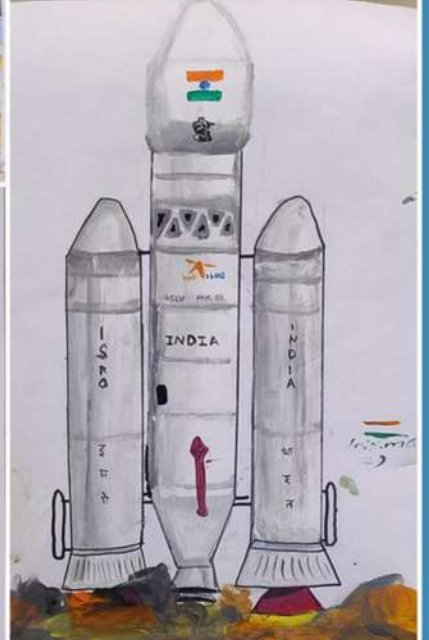
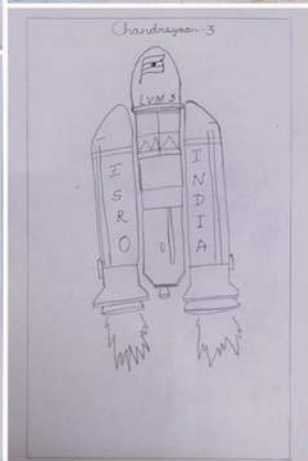
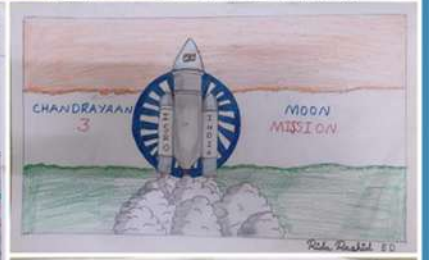
