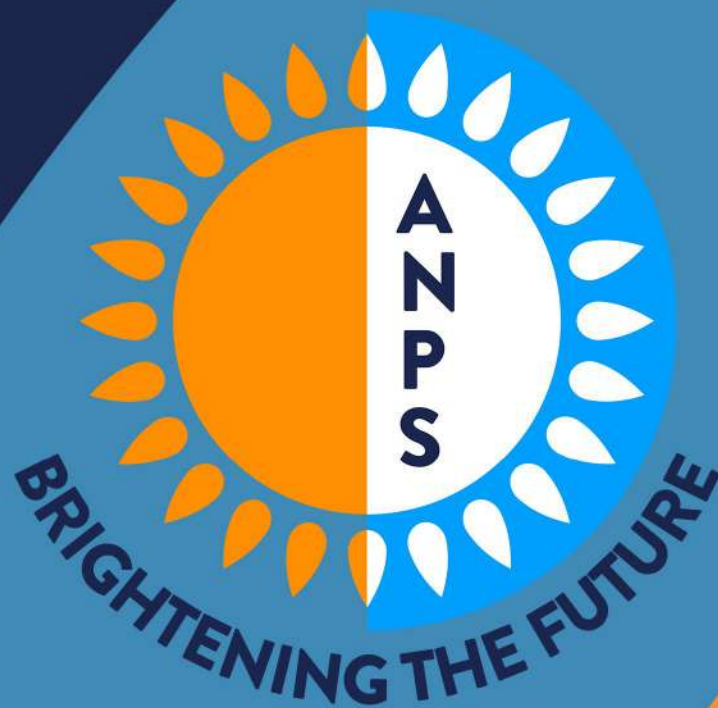

Students presented different types of models which were related to Chemistry, Biology, Physics, Mathematics, Geography, History, Civics, Kannada, Hindi, English, and Art.

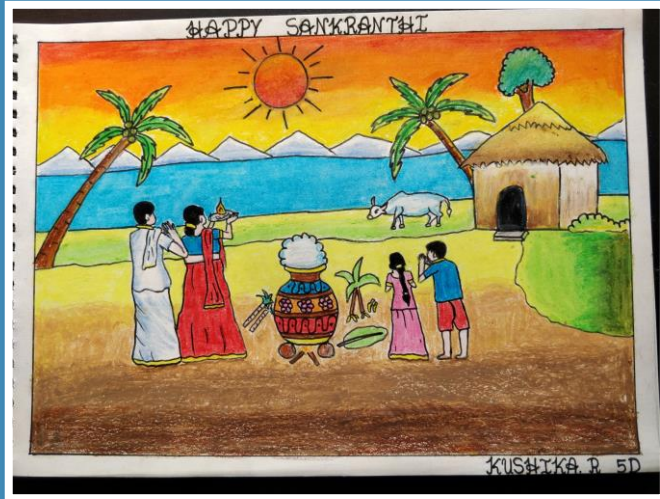

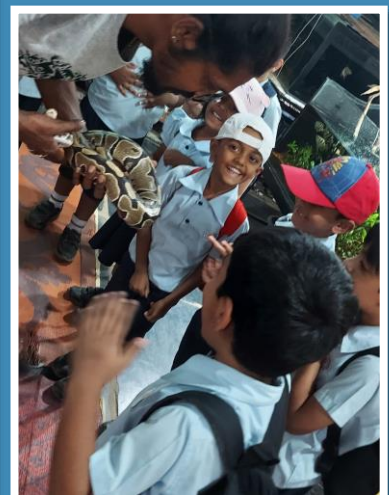
Primary trip 1 to 5

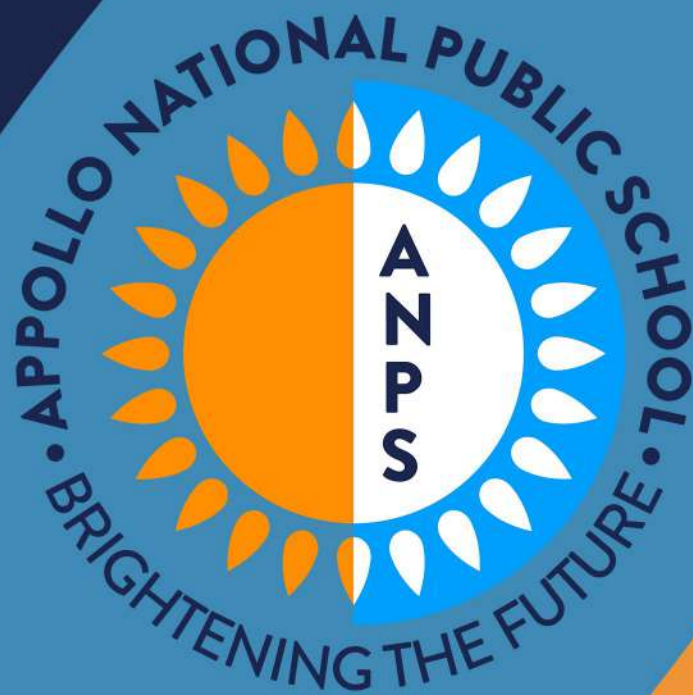
PG trip
