

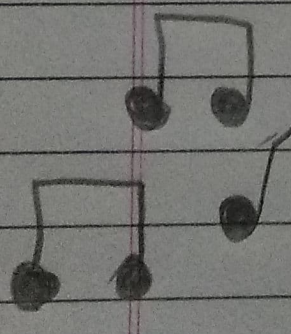
Music Magic

The flute is a family of musical instruments in the woodwind group. Unlike woodwind instruments with reeds, a flute is a aerophone or reedless wind instrument that produces its sound from the flow of air across an opening.

In China, a playable bone flute was discovered, dated approximately 9000 year old.

Modern versions of this flute are still used in the Middle East today.

The ancient Greeks used panpipes, probably indirectly influenced by more sophisticated Chinese versions. The transverse flute was used in Greece and Etruria by the second century B.C. and later appeared in India, China and Japan.
